Bundesliga remains most attended football league in the world

League registers one of the highest spectator average per match since inception in 1963

The excitement and thrill of Bundesliga football has once again proven to be unmatched, as the league enjoyed one of its most attended seasons in history.

With 12,980,815 spectators passing through the stadiums and a season average of 42,421 fans per match, the Bundesliga registered as the highest attended football league in international football. This achievement in large part can be attributed to the immense fan support of top-tier clubs like Borussia Dortmund and Bayern München, which led the league in attendance.

Borussia Dortmund averaged 81,178 (99.88% capacity) fans per match, with Bayern München drawing 75,018 (100% capacity).

Fans are already eager for the start of the upcoming season, as the German Supercup match on August 14 between Borussia Dortmund and Bayern München at the SIGNAL IDUNA PARK has already sold out.
